 - a. The Lord presents his case against his people, 6:1-2 the Lord and Judge over all creation demands our total and undivided attention no dismissive, defensive, or deflective attitude that denies the relevance of his charges
 - b. The Lord defends his actions for his people, 6:3-5 whenever we feel emotionally bummed out or distant from the Lord, that's an ideal time to mull over his righteous and gracious deeds on our behalf
- 2. We Must Always Remember the Lord's Requirement for Us, 6:6-8
 - a. What we value in our worship, 6:6-7 like ancient Israel, it's possible for us to zoom in on the wrong set of questions
 - b. What the Lord expects from our worship, 6:8 act justly
