

A Raid on ISIS Yields a Trove Of Intelligence

New Challenges and Tactics Take Shape

WASHINGTON — American intelligence agencies have extracted valuable information about the Islamic State's leadership structure, financial operations and security measures by analyzing materials seized during a Delta Force commando raid last month that killed a leader of the terrorist group in eastern Syria, according to United States officials.

The information harvested from the laptops, cellphones and other materials recovered from the raid on May 16 has already helped the United States identify, locate and carry out an airstrike against another Islamic State leader in eastern Syria, on May 31. American officials expressed confidence that an influential lieutenant, Abu Hamid, was killed in the attack, but the Islamic State, which remains resilient, has not yet confirmed his death.

New insights yielded by the seized trove — four to seven terabytes of data, according to one official — include how the organization's shadowy leader, Abu Bakr al-Baghdadi, operates and tries to avoid being tracked by

coalition forces.

PASSPORT LAW ON JERUSALEM

SIDE WITH WHITE HOUSE

Decision Against Israel Designation Affirms Separate Powers

WASHINGTON — In an important separation-of-powers case, the Supreme Court on Monday struck down a law that would have allowed American parents of children born in Jerusalem to obtain passports saying the children were born in Israel. The president, rather than Congress, must determine national policy on the status of Jerusalem, the majority said.

The decision came against the backdrop of generations of conflict in the Middle East and long-standing tensions between Congress and presidents on the conduct of foreign policy there. The vote was 6 to 3, with Chief Justice John G. Roberts Jr. and Justices Antonin Scalia and Samuel A. All-to Jr. dissenting.

Justice Anthony M. Kennedy, writing for five justices, said the court had approached the ques-




