The hope that we give to others comes from the peace that we receive from God.

## 1. A Life-Threatening Predicament Generates Widespread Panic, 27:1-20

a. The critical situation, 27:1-12

Luke emphasizes the enormous challenges that they encountered in this final voyage to Rome

#### b. The devastating realization, 27:13-20

despite doing all that they can, with all hands literally on deck, most everyone comes to the sobering realization that they cannot save themselves from dying at sea (it's in this place that we're best prepared to hear God speak and see him work)

## 2. A Life-Saving Prophet Delivers Overwhelming Peace, 27:21-44

a. The gracious promise, 27:21-26

we can reassure others with the same truth that God has revealed to us - our confidence that God will do as he says can move others to rely on him also

### b. The providential fulfillment, 27:27-44

the boat is lost, but the people are saved - God does exactly what he told Paul he would graciously do for him and all who were sailing with him (like Paul, we want to show others that both we and the God whom we worship are trustworthy)
