

# Watch over your heart with all diligence, For from it flow the springs of life Proverbs 4:23

### As in water face reflects face, so the heart of man reflects man. Prov 27:19

You shall love the Lord your God with all your heart... (Mk 12:30)

When Jesus perceived their thoughts, he said, Why do you respond with evil in your hearts? (Matt 9:4)

But to this day the Lord has not given you a heart to understand or eyes to see or ears to hear. (Deut 29:4)

The heart of man plans his way, but the Lord establishes his steps. (Prov 16:9)

#### Your heart is YOU!



Note the parallel: You now have sorrow, but ... your heart will rejoice. (John 16:22)



My heart said to you, "Your face, O Lord, will I seek." (Ps 27:8)

Implications?

#### The heart is deep...

For the inward nature and the human heart-how deep they are! (Ps. 64:6)

The purpose in a man's heart is like deep water. (Prov 20:5)



Implications?

#### The heart is God's "forum" to engage us.

God opens our heart (Acts 16:14).

God speaks to our heart [love and comfort] (Hos 2:14; Is 40:2).


God shines the light of his glory in Christ in our heart (2 Cor 4:6; Eph 1:18)

Christ and the Spirit dwell in our heart (Eph 3:17, Gal 4:6).

God pours his love into our heart (Ro 5:5).

#### » Our heart directs us...

Source of our speech and actions.

For the mouth speaks out of that which fills the heart. (Matt 12:34-35)

Key: Emotions reveal the heart!

The boundaries/limits/"issues" of our life. (Prov 4:23)

#### And is directed by us:

- "Watch over"/"guard with diligence" your heart (Prov 4:23!)
- "Direct" your heart in the way (Prov 23:19)
- "Do not store up"/"Store up" treasures (Matt 6:19-21)
- "Bind" things to your heart (Prov 3:1-3; 6:21)
- "Impress" [truth] upon your heart (Deut 11:18)
