(Gen 8:21)




In the Bible, the +++ opposite of evil

Who shall dwell on your Holy hill? He who,... speaks truth in his heart. (Ps 15:2)


So teach us to number our days that we may get a heart of wisdom. (Ps 90:12)

God's provision for our "heart transplant"

A heart of flesh, not stone (Ezek 36:27)

= a new responsiveness to God

The law withinwritten on our heart (Jer 31:33)

- = a new depth of knowledge of God (Jer 24:7)
- = a new enablement to walk in His ways (Jer 24:7)



A new love is the "engine" of the new heart

Love for God (1 John 5:2-3)

Love for Christ (1 John 5:1)

Love for God's people (1 John 3:14; 4:7)

Love for righteousness (God's law) (1 John 2:29; 3:9; 5:18)
