







MERCY OUTREACH MINISTIRES Southeast Asia Summer Mission Trips /Medical

Trip 1 Aug 11 - 23; Trip 2 Medical - Aug 14 - 23 Bangkok, Thailand then to Myanmar or Laos

Myanmar has endured immense suffering in recent years. The recent **7.7 earthquake** and a deepening civil war have left countless families torn apart and forced many from their homes. Among the most vulnerable are the youth—young lives uprooted, uncertain, and longing for hope.

In the midst of this heartbreak, God led us to a faithful local pastor who has become a beacon of light in the darkness. **This pastor has opened both his heart and home to care for displaced youth, offering not just shelter, but love, dignity, and education**. He has begun a small school to serve these children—an act of courage and compassion that has profoundly touched our team. This summer, our mission trip will stand alongside his efforts. **We aim to strengthen the foundation of this growing ministry**, and, with God's guidance, take steps toward **Establishing an International School**—a place where these young hearts can find not just learning, but belonging and healing. Our youth can also serve there.

We've seen the power of education before. The San Telmo School now educates over 300 students. There, the Field of Grace young missionaries serve tirelessly for nine months at a time, pouring themselves into the lives of children. That same spirit is what we hope to carry into Myanmar.

On this Southeast Asia mission trip, our hearts are set on more than just buildings—we want to cultivate a space that nurtures education and the Word. The site will be a place for education and for our young people to teach for short stints and a training place for our future missionaries.

Before heading into the field, **our team will gather in Bangkok for a three-day training program** to prepare both hearts and minds. Our youth will also practice and develop their presentation skills, which they will share with hundreds throughout the trip.

Two teams will be sent out:

• One team will serve in **Laos**, continuing years of ministry to the Hmong people through village outreach and church partnerships.

• The other team will serve in **Myanmar**, where doctors and dentists will minister to communities near Yangon, especially focusing on the school site and surrounding areas.

We invite you to **partner with us in this important work**. Your prayers and support can help turn a vision into reality—a school that becomes a sanctuary, a training ground, a launching pad for change. Together, we can bring hope where it's needed most, and show these displaced youth that they are not forgotten. Let's be part of something bigger than ourselves. What/Where/When: Aug 11 - 23. Depart LAX Aug 11. Return to LAX Aug 23. Aug 12 to Aug 14, Bangkok Thailand. (Youth Ministry Training) Depart LAX Aug 11. Fly to Bangkok. Youth Ministry training. DTS/VBS. THEN DIVIDE INTO TWO TEAMS.

Team I to: Yangon, Myanmar. Aug 15 to Aug 22.

Fly to Yangon from Bangkok. We will partner with a local pastor in Yangon to minister to displaced youth and underprivileged communities. Also it is a planning trip for building a future International

School to serve these youth. Medical and dental team will join us. See below.

Team II to: Vientiane and surrounding area, Laos. Aug 15 to Aug 22.

Different teams will serve the Hmong in multiple locations. Fly to Vientiane, Laos. Serve in different villages.

Aug 14 to Aug 23 Medical/Dental Mission to Yangon, Myanmar

Depart LAX Aug 14 to Bangkok. Aug 15 - Fly to Yangon. Join the rest of the team. Serve in several villages. Aug 22– Fly from Yangon to Bangkok. Aug 23– Fly to LAX.
