Summer is around the corner and we're excited to share these transformative mission opportunities with you. Each trip offers a unique way to serve and make a lasting impact:

1) Southeast Asia Mission (August 11-23) (attached is a newsletter describing the mission trips in more detail)

Embark on a life-changing journey to Southeast Asia, beginning with three days of spiritual preparation and team building in Bangkok. From there, join one of two vital ministry teams:

Myanmar Team: Work alongside a dedicated local pastor in Yangon who is bringing hope to youth displaced by civil unrest. We'll minister in underserved communities while our medical and dental volunteers provide essential healthcare.

Laos Team: Serve the Hmong people—resilient communities facing significant challenges and persecution throughout the region. We'll partner with local churches to strengthen believers and reach out to those who have yet to hear the Gospel message.

Develop meaningful relationships with children eager for education and mentorship. Experience personal spiritual growth while serving in a cross-cultural setting
