We lead worship of our Father by living well as Jesus' disciples.

1. Authentic Worshipers Magnify our Father for his Perfect Goodness

- a. The gratitude that we offer to God (Psalm 107:1-3; 145:8-9)
by simply telling others how God has been good to us, we magnify his name and accentuate his worth

- b. The petitions that we present to God (Matthew 7:7-11; James 1:17)
our perception of God shapes our posture (courageous, persistent) as well as our petition (ask for the right thing, wait for the right time)

- c. The works that we do for God (Ephesians 2:8-10)
as a faith community formed in Christ and united by his Spirit, what are the good works that we should walk in as God's masterpiece of grace?

2. Observant Unbelievers Glorify our Father for our Consistent Goodness

- a. The invite that we extend to others (Psalm 34:1, 8-10)
in our praise to God we can also urge others to discover his goodness firsthand

- b. The example that we model before others (Matthew 5:14-16; Romans 12:9, 17-21)
what the world sees in us determines what they say about God

- c. The habit that we practice with others (Hebrews 3:12-13; 10:24-25)
daily, personal encouragement protects us from apostasy and propels us to maturity
