Be universally good to others since God has been uniquely good to us.

1. Recall the Practical Implication of Our Faith as Christians, 3:1-3

- a. Our present resolution to do good, 3:1-2 we often don't necessarily need new information, but a prompt to recall and follow the truth we already know
- b. Our past inclination to do evil, 3:3 a balance to the seven commands that Paul reiterates for us, he also identifies seven patterns that applied to us prior to putting our faith in Jesus

2. Recite the Essential Foundation of Our Faith in Christ, 3:4-11

- a. The appearance of God's goodness, 3:4-7 what reverses our eternal destiny: the goodness and loving kindness of God our Savior appeared what signifies our eternal destiny: the washing of the Holy Spirit through Jesus Christ our Savior
- b. The evidence of our goodness, 3:8-11 with the appearance of God's goodness through the sacrifice of his Son and the outpouring of his Spirit, it's fitting that we bring his goodness to others by serving and loving them
