4:36 Thus Joseph, who was also called by the apostles Barnabas (which means son of encouragement)

12:12 ... he went to the house of Mary, the mother of John whose other name was Mark, where many were gathered together and were praying.

13:13 Now Paul and his companions set sail from Paphos and came to Perga in Pamphylia. And John left them and returned to Jerusalem,

4:11 Luke alone is with me. Get Mark and bring him with you, for he is very useful to me for ministry
